10 This bill proposes to enhance the visibility of pedestrian
crosswalks. Under this bill, the Department of Transportation

of pedestrian crosswalks, with particular emphasis on enhancing
the safety of crosswalks that cross more than 2 lanes of traffic,
14 as is the case in Westbrook.
