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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 474, L.D. 644, Bill, "An Act To Assist Low-income Families To Comply with the Booster Seat Law"

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Amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph A in the last line (page 2, line 3 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "2005" the following: ' , except that the operator shall ensure that the child is properly secured in a seat belt '

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SUMMARY

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
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This amendment clarifies that a nonprofit, municipal or contracted transportation service provider is exempt from securing a child less than 8 years of age and who weighs at least 40 pounds but less than 80 pounds in a federally approved child restraint system, except that the operator shall ensure that the child is properly secured in a seat belt.
