HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 474, L.D. 644, Bill, "An Act To Assist Low-income Families To Comply with the Booster Seat Law"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the first indented paragraph and the underlined blocked paragraph (page 2, lines 16 to 23 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 1, lines 38 to 40 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'A written warning must be issued in lieu of a fine for a violation of subsection 3 until February 1, 2005. Beginning February 1, 2005, a fine may be imposed for a violation of subsection 3.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that a written warning be issued for a violation of the so-called "booster seat law" until February 1, 2005, the same date of the end of the exemption from the booster seat law for nonprofit, municipal or contracted service providers as provided in Committee Amendment "A." Beginning February 1, 2005, a fine may be imposed for a violation.
