SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 486, L.D. 656, Bill, "An Act to Allow Beverage Sales from Mobile Service Bars on Golf Courses"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "~~§1075-A.~~" in subsection 2 in the first line (page 1, line 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "The bureau" and inserting in its place the following: 'If a licensee has obtained approval from the Department of Human Services for sufficient toilet facilities, the bureau' '

Further amend the amendment in the first indented paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the summary the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. Rulemaking. The Commissioner of Human Services shall adopt rules governing the number of toilet facilities required in order to obtain a license for a golf course mobile service bar pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28-A, section 1075-A. 
