COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 489, L.D. 659, Bill, "An Act To Standardize Reporting Requirements for PACs, Parties and Independent Electioneering Expenditures"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Standardize Reporting Requirements for State Party Committees' Expenditures and Contributions'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 4-A in the first line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "A" the following: 'state'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 4-A in paragraph D in the first line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "A" the following: 'state'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 4-A in paragraph E in the first line (page 2, line 11 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "A" the following: 'state'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 4 and 6.

This amendment strikes the section of the bill that creates a specific schedule for any person, party committee, political committee or political action committee that makes an independent expenditure. It also amends the section of the bill that creates a specific schedule for party committees to file reports of contributions and expenditures by specifying that this schedule only applies to state party committees.
