SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 237, L.D. 673, Bill, "An Act To Increase Maine's Minimum Wage"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 2. Reprinting of notice. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 42-B, the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards is not required to modify and redistribute the printed notice required by that section to reflect the changes in the law resulting from this Act. The Bureau of Labor Standards shall modify the printed notice to reflect the changes contained in this Act when it becomes necessary to print additional notices due to an insufficient supply of such notices or due to future changes in law.'

SUMMARY


This amendment provides that the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards is not required to modify and redistribute the printed notice required by law to reflect the changes in the law made in the bill. The bureau shall modify the printed notice to reflect those changes when it becomes necessary to print additional notices due to an insufficient supply of such notices
