HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 237, L.D. 673, Bill, "An Act To Increase Maine's Minimum Wage"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §664, as amended by PL 2003, c. 423, §§1 and 2 and affected by §5, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Employees who are under the age of 19 and are regularly enrolled in an educational institution or are on vacation therefrom may be paid a rate of not less than 75% of the applicable minimum wage rate required for other employees in the same occupation.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that employees under 19 years of age must be paid at a rate no lower than 75% of regular minimum wage.
