18 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 509, L.D. 692, Bill, "An
20 Act To Protect Consumer Privacy Rights"

22 Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated
24 "~~§1272-B.~~" by striking out all of the indented paragraph (page 1,
lines 7 to 10 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

26 'Except as otherwise provided in federal or state law, a
28 person, corporation or other entity may not deny goods or
services to an individual because the individual refuses to
30 provide a social security number. This section does not apply to
a financial institution as defined in Title 9-B, section 131.'

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SUMMARY

36 This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing
38 Committee on Business, Research and Economic Development. The
amendment clarifies that social security numbers may be required
40 for certain transactions under current federal or state law and
exempts financial institutions from the bill's prohibition.
