2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1272-B** is enacted to read:

6 **§1272-B. Refusal to provide social security number**

8 Except as otherwise provided in law, a person, corporation
10 or other entity may not deny goods or services to an individual
12 because the individual refuses to provide a social security
14 number.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill prohibits the denial of goods or services to an
20 individual because the individual refuses to provide a social
security number. The bill does not prevent collection of social
security numbers when provided for in current law.
