HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 510, L.D. 693, Bill, "An Act To Ensure the Safety of Children Touring Hazardous Facilities"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§590-F.~~" by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 1, lines 37 to 44 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Prior to allowing students of a public or private school to enter a resource recovery facility that burns municipal solid waste for the purpose of touring the facility:'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provisions of Committee Amendment "A" that prohibit resource recovery facilities that burn municipal solid waste from permitting students who have not yet entered 7th grade to enter the facility for the purpose of touring the facility.
