COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 518, L.D. 701, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Suspension of Licenses for Failure To Pay a Fine"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§8006.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph D in the 2nd line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or apply for"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§8006.~~" in subsection 3 in the last 3 lines (page 2, lines 17 to 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "When the applicant or licensee pays the court-ordered fine in full and a reinstatement fee of \$35, the license or right to apply for a license must be reinstated."

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "~~§3142.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the first line (page 2, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the right to apply for or possess"

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes from the bill the proposed authority of the court to suspend the right to apply for a license or
