	A. A complete financial account of income and expenditures
12	pertaining to the waterway;
14	B. A summary of use of the waterway, including a breakdown
	of day use and overnight use;

	C. A summary of management activities on the waterway and
18	steps taken to develop the maximum wilderness character of
	the waterway;

	D. A description of steps taken to ensure compliance with
22	the waterway's status under the federal Wild and Scenic
	Rivers Act, 16 United States Code, Sections 1271 to 1287; and

	E. A description of any anticipated changes in management
26	strategy and issues of continuing concern in the subsequent
	report period.
