44	A. For children 6 weeks to one year of age: one staff person for every 4 children, with a group size limit of 8;
46	B. For children one year to 2 years of age: one staff
48	person for every 5 children, with a group size limit of 10;
50	<u>C. For children 2 years to 3 years of age: one staff person</u> for every 7 children, with a group size limit of 21;
