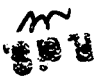

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HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1209, L.D. 1629, "RESOLUTION, Proposing a Competing Measure under the Constitution of Maine To Create Municipal Service Districts To Reduce the Cost of Local Government, To Provide Property Tax Relief and To Increase Economic Competitiveness"

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Amend the amendment by inserting after Part B the following:

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PART C

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Sec. C-1. Analysis and report. By January 2, 2010, the Department of Education and the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services shall jointly analyze the effectiveness of this resolution in lowering property taxes and in meeting the goals of funding public education. The Department of Education and the Bureau of Revenue Services shall submit a report by January 1, 2010 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters containing their findings and recommendations. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters may report out legislation if necessary to the Second Regular Session of the 124th Legislature by March 1, 2010 to accomplish the tax reduction and education funding goals of this resolution.'

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Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment requires the Department of Education and the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services to review the effectiveness of this resolution in lowering property taxes and meeting the goals of education funding and to report their findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters in 2010. The committee is authorized to report out legislation if necessary to further the goals of this resolution.
