HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1299, L.D. 1777, Bill, "An Act To Authorize the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services To Execute Easements"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§282-A." in subsection 1 by inserting at the end a blocked paragraph to read:

'The authority granted to the commissioner under this subsection does not apply to state park lands protected by the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 23 and designated in Title 12, section 598-A.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the power granted to the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services in the bill to issue or receive nonfee interests in state lands does not apply to state park lands protected by the Constitution of Maine.
