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	SUMMARY
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	This bill requires municipalities to submit copies of their
10	annual budgets to the State Planning Office, which will compile
	the information and make it available on a publicly accessible
12	site on the Internet. A municipality that fails to submit a
	copy of its budget as required is ineligible to receive funds
14	under state-municipal revenue sharing.

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
