If the CAARC does not purchase the state property, the state property may be offered for sale to another social service agency and must be used for nonprofit purposes; and be it further'

34 This amendment allows the state property to be sold to another social service agency if the Central Aroostook 36 Association for Retarded Citizens does not purchase the property and requires the property to be used for nonprofit purposes.
