HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1324, L.D. 1802, Bill, "An Act To Permit the Photocopying of Driver's Licenses in Financial Transactions"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Permit the Photocopying of Driver's Licenses'

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment in the emergency preamble by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd paragraphs (page 1, lines 30 to 38 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment in the emergency preamble by striking out all of the 6th and 7th paragraphs (page 1, lines 48 to 50 and page 2, lines 2 to 4 in amendment and inserting in their place the following:

'Whereas, this statutory provision permits the photocopying of a driver's license; and'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1401, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

1-A. Notice required on license. A license issued on or after January 1, 2006 must contain the following statement: "This

2 license is a form of personal identification. A licensee must
3 exercise caution when allowing a person to view, record or copy
4 any information displayed on this license."

5 Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2103, sub-§4-A is enacted to read:

7 4-A. Photocopy of driver's license. Notwithstanding
8 subsection 4, a person who makes a photocopy of a driver's
9 license without the written consent of the Secretary of State
10 does not commit a Class D crime pursuant to subsection 4.'

11 SUMMARY

12
13 This amendment provides that a person who makes a photocopy
14 of a driver's license without the written consent of the
15 Secretary of State does not commit a crime. The amendment also
16 requires that, beginning in 2006, all driver's licenses must
17 contain a warning related to disclosure of personal information
18 displayed on a license.
