HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1342, L.D. 1820, Bill, "An Act To Establish the Gambling Control Board To License and Regulate Slot Machines at Commercial Harness Racing Tracks"

Amend the amendment on page 14 in the 2nd occurrence of subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 14, line 45 in amendment) by striking out the following: "39%" and inserting in its place the following: '43%'

Further amend the amendment on page 16, line 9 by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the amendment on page 16 in paragraph J in the last line (page 16, line 13 in amendment) by striking out the following: "located." and inserting in its place the following: 'located; and'

Further amend the amendment on page 16 by inserting after paragraph J the following:


'K. Four percent of the total gross slot machine income must be deposited in the General Fund.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides for an additional distribution of 4% of the total gross slot machine income, which must be deposited
