SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1342, L.D. 1820, Bill, "An Act To Establish the Gambling Control Board To License and Regulate Slot Machines at Commercial Harness Racing Tracks"

Amend the amendment on page 17 by inserting after Part B, section 8 the following:

Sec. B-9. Establishment by January 1, 2005. If a person who has been granted a license to operate a slot machine pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 8, chapter 31, subchapter 2 fails to establish a slot machine facility, as defined in Title 8, section 1001, by January 1, 2005, then the Gambling Control Board established in Title 8, chapter 31 shall revoke the license issued to that person and reopen the bidding process for the establishment and operation of a slot machine facility.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires a person licensed to operate a slot machine facility to establish and operate that slot machine facility by January 1, 2005; failure to do so will result in



Fiscal Detail and Notes

The fiscal estimate for this bill currently presumes that a licensed facility will begin operating by January 2005. Under the requirements of this amendment, if the licensed facility is not operational by January 1, 2005 and the licensing process is reopened, the subsequent delay will result in significant changes for the funding impacts previously identified. The changed amounts will depend on the date by which a new licensee is approved by the Gambling Control Board and can not be determined at this time.
