The central site 4 monitoring system, in addition to other functions the board determines necessary, must: б A. Be a fully operational slot machine control system that 8 has the capability of supporting all slot machines licensed for operation in the State and is capable of being upgraded 10 to maintain a fully operational and proper reporting capability; 12 Use a widely accepted gaming industry protocol to <u>B.</u> facilitate slot machine manufacturers' ability to 14 communicate with the central site monitoring system; 16 C. Have the capability to support progressive slot machines, both in-house and wide-area, as approved by the 18 board. For purposes of this paragraph, "progressive slot 20 machine" means a slot machine or series of slot machines in which the payback amount to an individual player increases 22 as that player continues to play the slot machine or slot machines; 24 D. Allow the slot machine operator to install independent 26 player tracking systems to include cashless technology as approved by the board; 28 E. Be incapable of altering the statistical awards of slot 30 machines, as designated by the slot machine manufacturer and approved by the board; 32 F. Provide redundancy to ensure that each component of the network is capable of operating independently if another 34 component of the network fails and to ensure that all 36 transactional data is captured and secured; and G. Have the ability to meet the reporting and control 38 requirements set forth in section 1003, subsection 2, 40 paragraphs A to T. 2. Third-party contractor. If the board contracts with a 42 3rd party to operate the central site monitoring system, the 3rd party must meet, as determined by the board, the suitability 44 requirement described in section 1016, subsection 2. A slot machine distributor or slot machine operator licensed pursuant to 46 this chapter or any holding company, intermediary company or 48 subsidiary of a slot machine distributor or slot machine operator licensed pursuant to this chapter may not act as a 3rd-party

<u>contractor for purposes of operation of the central site</u> monitoring system.

 3. Initial acquisition of central site monitoring system. The board shall select the central site monitoring system
presenting the lowest overall cost alternative, taking into consideration the capital costs, operating costs and impact on
gross slot machine revenues, that is capable of satisfying the requirements of this section and section 1003, as determined by
the board.'

Further amend the bill in section 4 by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.'

## **SUMMARY**

18 This amendment incorporates the provisions of Senate Amendment "C" to Committee Amendment "A" and adds a provision 20 prohibiting a slot machine distributor or slot machine operator licensed in this State or any entity affiliated with that slot 22 machine distributor or slot machine operator from acting as a 3rd-party contractor for purposes of operating the central site 24 monitoring system.
