HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1342, L.D. 1820, Bill, "An Act To Establish the Gambling Control Board To License and Regulate Slot Machines at Commercial Harness Racing Tracks"

Amend the bill in Part A by inserting after section 7 the following:

'Sec. A-8. 21-A MRSA §1015, sub-§10 is enacted to read:

10. Contributions from individuals licensed to conduct gambling. A candidate, political committee, party or party committee may not accept a campaign contribution from any individual or corporation that is licensed by the State to conduct gambling activities. For purposes of this subsection, "gambling activities" means off-track betting, pari-mutuel wagering at a race track, a game of chance, as defined in Title 17, section 330, subsection 2, or operation of a slot machine, as defined in Title 8, section 1001, but does not include nonprofit organizations licensed to conduct beano and games of chance or those licensed to conduct high-stakes beano.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the campaign finance laws to prohibit candidates, political committees, parties or party committees
