SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1342, L.D. 1820, Bill, "An Act To Establish the Gambling Control Board To License and Regulate Slot Machines at Commercial Harness Racing Tracks"

Amend the bill in Part A in section 4 in that part designated "~~§1031.~~" by striking out all of the first line (page 23, line 30 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'§1031. Age limit on slot machine use; access by minors; credit prohibited'

Further amend the bill in Part A in section 4 in that part designated "~~§1031.~~" by inserting at the end the following:

'3. Credit prohibited. A slot machine operator may not allow the use of a credit card or debit card by a person to play a slot machine.'

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits the use of a credit card or debit card to play slot machines.
