HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1351, L.D. 1828, Bill, "An Act To Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and To Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary for the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2004 and June 30, 2005"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part CC the following:

'PART DD

Sec. DD-1. Distribution of funding. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapters 606 and 606-A, the incremental change in funds to the general purpose aid for local schools program within the Department of Education in fiscal year 2004-05 from the funds appropriated in fiscal year 2003-04 must be distributed proportionally to each local school unit by applying the percent change in appropriations over fiscal year 2003-04 levels to the amount of state funding received by each school administrative unit in fiscal year 2003-04.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

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This amendment requires that if there is any incremental
change in fiscal year 2004-05 in funds to the general purpose aid
for local schools program from the amount appropriated in fiscal
year 2003-04, then the percentage change must be distributed
proportionately to school administrative units.


