HOUSE AMENDMENT "N" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1351, L.D. 1828, Bill, "An Act To Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and To Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary for the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2004 and June 30, 2005"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part F and inserting in its place the following:

**PART F**

**Sec. F-1. General Purpose Aid for Local Schools, General Fund account; fiscal year 2004-05.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, \$1,365,855 of the unencumbered balance forward in fiscal year 2003-04 in the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools, General Fund account in the Department of Education must be distributed to the local school units in fiscal year 2004-05 through the funding formula.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes that part of Committee Amendment "A" that lapses \$1,365,855 of the unencumbered balance forward in fiscal year 2003-04 in the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools,

**Fiscal Detail and Notes**

As amended, this bill requires the Department of Education to distribute \$1,365,855 of the unencumbered balance forward in fiscal year 2003-04 in the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools General Fund account to the local school administrative units through the funding formula in fiscal year 2004-05.

This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$1,365,855 in fiscal year 2003-04.
