SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1382, L.D. 1856, Bill, "An Act To Implement the Recommendations of the Commission To Improve the Sentencing, Supervision, Management and Incarceration of Prisoners"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1-A in the last blocked paragraph in the 2nd line (page 2, line 47 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "15" and inserting in its place the following: '30'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 2 in the last 2 lines (page 3, lines 11 and 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "meet as often as necessary to complete its final report within authorized resources" and inserting in its place the following: 'meet no more than 4 times to complete its final report under section 7'

Further amend the bill in section 6 in subsection 7 in the 3rd line (page 3, line 36 in L.D.) by inserting before the following: "budgeted" the following: 'authorized number of meeting days and'

Further amend the bill in section 7 in the last line (page 4, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "January 1, 2005" and inserting in its place the following: 'November 3, 2004'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 7 the following:

'Sec. 8. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
