HOUSE AMENDMENT "*F*" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1418, L.D. 1916, Bill, "An Act To Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine"

Amend the amendment in Part B in section 6 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (3) (page 3, lines 29 to 37 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'(3) Is not qualified to be a registered voter because the challenged person:

(a) Does not meet the age requirements as specified in sections 111, subsection 2 and section 111-A;

(b) Is not a citizen of the United States; or

(c) Is not a resident of the municipality or appropriate electoral district within the municipality;'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the statute pertaining to the challenge of voter qualifications to reflect the change in age for persons voting in primary elections made by Public Law 2003, chapter 577.
