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10 This amendment strikes Part BBB of Committee Amendment "A,"
which deals with authorizing payment to those employees who were
denied merit increases in fiscal year 2003-04 and payment to

eligible to receive a step increase from Step 6 to Step 7 during
14 the period of July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004. This amendment
appropriates funds to establish a veterans cemetery in Springvale.
