SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 767, L.D. 1930, Bill, "An Act To Promote Intergovernmental Cooperation, Cost Savings and Efficiencies"

Amend the amendment in section 12 in that part designated "~~§2181.~~" by striking out all of subsection 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'5. Meetings. The advisory group may meet up to 4 times a year.'

Further amend the amendment in section 12 in that part designated "~~§2181.~~" by striking out all of subsections 7 and 8 and inserting in their place the following:

'7. Staff assistance. The Executive Department, State Planning Office shall provide all necessary staffing and support services for the advisory group.'

'8. Funding. The advisory group is authorized to seek, accept and expend funding to carry out the advisory group's program activities, subject to approval by the Director of the State Planning Office within the Executive Department. All funds accepted must be forwarded to the Director of the State Planning Office, who shall administer all funds received by the advisory group.'

Further amend the amendment in section 12 in that part designated "~~§2181.~~" in subsection 9 in the first line (page 6, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "commission" and inserting in its place the following: 'advisory group'



Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment strikes the General Fund appropriation to the Legislature of \$3,230 in fiscal year 2004-05. Costs associated with legislative participation on the advisory group will be absorbed by the Legislative budget in fiscal year 2004-05. The amendment also moves a base allocation of \$500 from the Legislature to the State Planning Office in the event that additional dedicated revenue is received to carry out the advisory group's program activities. The State Planning Office will absorb the costs associated with staffing the Intergovernmental Advisory Group utilizing existing budgeted resources.
