SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1456, L.D. 1957, Bill, "An Act To Implement the Recommendations of the Committee To Study Compliance with Maine's Freedom of Access Laws"

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

**'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and**

**Whereas, it is important that the Committee to Study Compliance with Maine's Freedom of Access Laws, continued by this Act, be able to resume its work as soon as possible; and**

**Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '**

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 10 the following:

**'Sec. 11. Effective date. The following sections of this Act take effect 90 days after adjournment of the Second Special Session of the 121st Legislature:**

1. Those sections of this Act that amend the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 1, section 405, subsection 4 and Title 29-A, section 2251, subsection 7;
