SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 806, L.D. 1961, Bill, "An Act To Clarify Legislative Pay"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:


'Sec. 2. Lapse. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, \$770,000 of unencumbered balance in the Legislative account lapses to the General Fund at the end of fiscal year 2003-04.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment directs that \$770,000 of unencumbered balance in the Legislative account lapses to the General Fund in fiscal year 2003-04.
