COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 14, L.D. 9, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 11: Registration, Collection and Dissemination of Prescription Data Relating to Schedule II, III and IV Drugs, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Substance Abuse"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "authorized" the following: 'if the rule is amended to require audit review of the vendor for compliance with the terms of the contract regarding confidentiality of information concerning the prescription drug, prescriber, pharmacy, patient and dispenser'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment requires the major substantive rule of the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Substance Abuse regarding the Controlled Substances Prescription Monitoring Program to be amended to provide for auditing for compliance with contract terms on confidentiality.
