Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 3. Application. The requirements of this Act apply to all policies, contracts and certificates executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in this State on or after January 1, 2006. For purposes of this Act, all contracts are deemed to be renewed no later than the next yearly anniversary of the contract date.

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SUMMARY

This bill requires that all health care plans reimburse for mental health services provided by licensed marriage and family therapists. The bill applies to all policies issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2006.
