2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11152, sub-§7** is enacted to read:

6 7. Hunters 70 years of age or older. An antlerless deer
8 permit system adopted by the commissioner pursuant to this
10 section must include a provision that provides, upon application
12 to the commissioner, an antlerless deer permit to any hunter who
14 is 70 years of age or older and holds a valid hunting license.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill requires the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and
16 Wildlife to issue an antlerless deer permit to a hunter who is 70
years of age or older.
