42	This amendment is the majority report and replaces the language of the bill. The amendment prohibits a licensee or
44	licensee's employee or agent from selling, furnishing, giving or delivering liquor or imitation liquor to a person under 27 years
46	of age unless that person provides a reliable photographic identification showing that person is not a minor.
