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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT **5**" to S.P. 21, L.D. 82, Bill, "An Act To Suspend or Revoke Licenses and Permits Issued by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to a Person Convicted of Operating under the Influence"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2411, sub-§5-C is enacted to read:

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5-C. Suspension or revocation of hunting, fishing and trapping licenses. In addition to the penalties provided in subsections 5 and 5-B, the court may impose the following suspension or revocation of hunting, fishing and trapping licenses issued by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

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A. For a person having 3 OUI offenses within a 10-year period, the court may suspend that person's hunting, fishing and trapping licenses for a period of one year.

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B. For a person having 4 or more OUI offenses within a 10-year period, the court may suspend that person's hunting, fishing and trapping licenses for a period of at least one year and up to and including the permanent revocation of those licenses.'

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#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment is the minority report of the committee and replaces the bill. This amendment authorizes the court to

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suspend a person's hunting, fishing and trapping licenses for a period of one year after that person has been convicted of 3 OUI offenses within a 10-year period. For a person having 4 or more OUI offenses within a 10-year period, the court may suspend those licenses for a period of at least one year and up to and including the permanent revocation of those licenses.
