An Act To Amend the Law Governing the Storage of Spirits

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §453-C, sub-§3, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2003,
c. 639, §1, is amended to read:

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A. The off-site storage facility may not be used ~~only for~~
~~the storage of spirits for retail sales of spirits.~~ The
~~sales of spirits to an on-premises licensee must be~~
~~transacted at the licensed retail agency store.~~ The off-site
storage facility may be used only for the storage of spirits
or for reselling activities related to sales to an
on-premises licensee.

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SUMMARY

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This bill amends the law governing the storage of spirits by
a reselling agent. It allows transactions related to the sales
of spirits to an on-premises licensee to occur at the storage
facility.
