### **An Act To Require Informational Signs on the Maine Turnpike for The Theater at Monmouth**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1201, sub-§38, as amended by PL 1993, c. 612, §1, is further amended to read:

38. **Bates College.** The signs must be provided by Bates College. The Maine Turnpike shall erect one sign on the side of the northbound lanes between exits 12 75 and 13 80 and one sign on the side of the southbound lanes north of exit 13 80. The Maine Turnpike Authority is responsible for the maintenance of the signs; and

Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §1201, sub-§39, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 612, §2, is amended to read:

39. **Saco Plaza; facilities at former Exit 5.** Signs for the facilities permitted by Title-23, section 1967, subsection 5 must be installed and maintained along the northbound and southbound lanes of the Maine Turnpike at appropriate locations leading to and at the former exit 5 of the Maine Turnpike. The signs must be provided and maintained by the Maine Turnpike Authority. The signs must be paid for by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services and the owners or operators of any facilities described in the signs. The Department of Administrative and Financial Services and owners or operators of the facilities may decide upon the division of expenses.

One sign along the northbound lanes and one sign along the southbound lanes must incorporate the single or multicolored logos or designs used by the hotel or convention center operator. These signs must briefly describe the services available to the traveling public; and

Sec. 3. 23 MRSA §1201, sub-§40 is enacted to read:

40. **The Theater at Monmouth.** Two signs for the location of The Theater at Monmouth must be installed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike at appropriate locations leading to the Sabattus exit, one sign on the side of the northbound lanes and one sign on the side of the southbound lanes.

## SUMMARY

This bill requires that 2 directional signs for The Theater at Monmouth be placed on the Maine Turnpike near the Sabattus exit.
