COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 47, L.D. 141, Bill, "An Act To Ensure Proper Disposal of Debris and Protection of the Environment"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1306, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

6. Construction and demolition debris; moratoria on new licenses. The following moratoria are established.

A. The department may not issue a license to a facility to combust wood from construction and demolition debris in a boiler between the effective date of this subsection and January 1, 2008 unless that facility possesses a license to combust wood from construction and demolition debris on the effective date of this subsection.

B. The department may not issue a license to a facility to process construction and demolition debris between the effective date of this subsection and January 1, 2008 unless that facility possesses a license to process construction and demolition debris on the effective date of this subsection.'
