2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1306, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

6 **5. Construction and demolition debris in solid waste**  
8 **landfill or incineration facility.** After January 1, 2006, a  
10 person may not dispose of construction and demolition debris in a  
12 solid waste landfill or in an incineration facility in this State  
14 unless the structure from which the debris originated is or was  
16 located in this State.

16 This bill bans the disposal in a landfill or in an  
18 incineration facility of debris resulting from construction,  
remodeling, repair and demolition of structures unless the  
structure from which the debris originated is or was located in  
this State.
