22	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the
24	following:
26	Sec. 1. I.B. 1975, §3, 2nd ¶ is enacted to read:
28	The Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands may construct and maintain a trail, not more than one mile in
30	length, in the southeast corner of the Bigelow Preserve at a location and of a width to be determined and approved by the
32	bureau. The trail within the Preserve is to be a segment of a longer trail. The trail within the Preserve is for use by the
34	public at no charge for hiking, cross-country skiing and other compatible nonmotorized trail uses only. Motorized equipment and
36	vehicles may be used for the construction of the trail and for grooming of the cross-country ski trail. The Director of the
38	Bureau of Parks and Lands may enter into a lease or other agreement to facilitate the construction, operation or
40	maintenance of the trail by another entity consistent with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 1852. All necessary
42	permits and agreements for the trail to be located on land abutting the Preserve must be completed with the owners of the
44	abutting land prior to construction of the trail within the Preserve. If the segment of trail within the Preserve is not
46	constructed by December 31, 2008, this authorization terminates.'
