2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17057, sub-§3, ¶B.** as enacted by PL 2003, c.
632, §1, is repealed.

6 **Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §17057, sub-§3, ¶C** is enacted to read:

8 C. This subsection does not apply to home contact
10 information of a retirement system member or a benefit
12 recipient used only for membership recruitment purposes by a
14 nonprofit or public organization established to provide
16 programs, services and representation to Maine public sector
18 retirees.

16 SUMMARY

18 This bill allows the Maine State Retirement System to
20 provide the names and addresses of retirees to nonprofit or
22 public organizations established to provide programs and services
to Maine public sector retirees. This bill repeals the current
waiver provision in the current law.
