

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 224, L.D. 299, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine To Permit the Legislature To Allow the Current Use Valuation of Waterfront Land Used for or That Supports Commercial Fishing Activities"

Amend the resolution in subsection 2 in paragraph D in the first line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "land" the following: 'that is'
