## **Fiscal Note**

election in November. If the number or size of the referendum questions increases the ballot length, an additional appropriation of \$8,000 or more may be required.

#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

If approved by the voters and assuming redistricting can be accomplished in time for the elections in November of 2006, reducing the size of the Legislature by 2 senators and 52 representatives will result in cost savings to the legislative budget in the amount of \$2,039,005 in fiscal year 2006-07, \$1,807,991 in fiscal year 2007-08 and \$2,267,907 in fiscal year 2008-09. The Legislature would require a General Fund appropriation of \$400,000 in fiscal year 2005-06 to conduct the required redistricting.
