2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

4
6 **Whereas,** the ability of students of this State to attend
institutions of higher education may be adversely affected if
financial assistance is not available at the beginning of the
8 academic year; and

10 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
12 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
14 safety; now, therefore,

16 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

18 **Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §1036, sub-§2, ¶F,** as enacted by PL 2003, c.
687, Pt. A, §5 and affected by Pt. D, §11, is amended to read:

22 F. Two percent of the total gross slot machine income must
be forwarded by the board to the University of Maine System
Scholarship Fund created in Title 20-A, section ~~11631~~ 10909;

26 **Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §10909** is enacted to read:

28 **§10909. University of Maine System Scholarship Fund**

30 The University of Maine System Scholarship Fund is created
and established as a nonlapsing fund under the jurisdiction and
control of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine
System. All revenues credited to this fund must be distributed
as need-based scholarships for students attending the University
of Maine System. These scholarships may be awarded only to those
students who are residents of the State. The fund may not be
used for the costs of administering the scholarships. Fees
credited from the University of Maine System registration plate
pursuant to Title 29-A, section 456 may not be distributed as
scholarships to students attending the University of Maine System.

8 **Sec. 6. Transfer of funds.** All funds remaining in the
10 University of Maine System Scholarship Fund held by the Finance
12 Authority of Maine must be transferred to the Board of Trustees
14 of the University of Maine System to be deposited on July 1, 2005
16 in the University of Maine System Scholarship Fund created in the
18 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 10909.

20 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
22 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

24 **SUMMARY**

26 This bill eliminates the University of Maine System
28 Scholarship Fund currently held by the Finance Authority of Maine
30 and creates an identical fund to be administered by the Board of
32 Trustees of the University of Maine System. The bill also
34 requires the Finance Authority of Maine to transfer the funds
36 from the old fund to the new fund by July 1, 2005.
