Further amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 1 in 2 paragraph C in the 3rd line (page 2, line 46 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>exhibited</u>" the following: '<u>for</u> 4 <u>the purpose of making a copy of the motion picture</u>'

Further amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the last line (page 2, line 48 in L.D.) by
striking out the following: "<u>Class C</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>Class D</u>'

SUMMARY

14 This amendment retains the current 1/2 hour detention of persons suspected of stealing allowed merchants while waiting for 16 law enforcement to arrive. Instead of deeming the value of an audio or video recording to be \$5,000, the amendment authorizes 18 the value to be deemed to be more than \$500 but less than \$1,000, unless a higher value can be proven. The amendment also 20 specifies that the new crime requires that the purpose of the person filming be to make a copy of the motion picture and 22 reclassifies the crime as a Class D crime.
