2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3502, sub-§6** is enacted to read:

6 6. Liability. A transit district formed under this chapter
8 is a governmental entity for the purposes of Title 14, chapter
10 741.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill allows transit districts formed under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, chapter 163 by one or more municipalities to be treated as governmental entities for the purposes of the Maine Tort Claims Act.
