SUMMARY

This amendment removes the President of the Maine Community College System as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Maine School of Science and Mathematics. It changes the number of members appointed by the Governor from the general public to 10 and specifies that one of the 10 must be a graduate of the school and one must be a parent of a student or recent graduate of the school.
