HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 413, L.D. 1196, Bill, "An Act To Extend Civil Rights Protections to All People Regardless of Sexual Orientation"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 22 the following:

'Sec. 23. Construction. This Act may not be construed as preempting the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 19-A, section 701, subsections 1-A and 5.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the bill may not be construed as preempting the provisions of law that prohibit same-sex marriage.
