HOUSE AMENDMENT "I" to S.P. 413, L.D. 1196, Bill, "An Act To Extend Civil Rights Protections to All People Regardless of Sexual Orientation"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 22 the following:

**'Sec. 23. Construction.** This Act may not be construed to create, add, alter or abolish any right to marry that may exist under the Constitution of the United States, the Constitution of Maine or the laws of this State.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment provides that the bill may not be construed to change any right to marry that exists under the United States Constitution, the Maine Constitution or any law of this State.
